Introduction :-

India (*Bhārat*), the **Republic of India** (*Bhārat Gaṇarājya*) is the seventh-largest country by area, the second-most populous country, and the most populous democracy in the world having vibrant and diverse nation with many people of different castes and religions, speaking different languages are living together in complete harmony. National unity is significant for construction of a complete nation with the aim of **“One India, Excellent India”** (Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat). It was aptly said by **the Iron man of India -Shri Vallabh Bhai Patel** “Manpower without Unity is not a strength unless it is harmonized and united properly, then it becomes a spiritual power.”

In an official statement for Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) by the Ministry of Home Affairs quotes that the National Unity Day “will provide an opportunity to reaffirm the inherent strength and resilience of our nation to withstand the actual and potential threats to the unity, integrity and security of our country”. Run for Unity is a nationwide campaign organized to celebrate this occasion which signifies peace and harmony among the fellow citizens of the country. 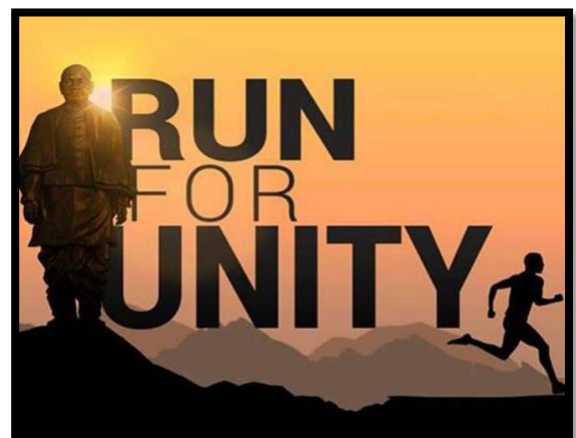


Essay writing :-
